New Bell Times

- This allows for increase in ratio of supervisor to student during the lunch time supervision. It has been transitional to start of year for the new times but so far there have been success in the lunch rooms.

Traffic & AMA Patrol

- AMA project to have Hug and Go patrolled by Grade 5/6 students and teachers.
 Training will begin in the upcoming weeks and then patrol will start. This will allow parents to drop child and child to be brought to line by patrol student/teacher.
 Hopeful to start at the first week of October. This is to improve flow and safety of traffic during drop off and pick up. Crosswalk not possible close to the doors due to residential neighbours.
